The great table



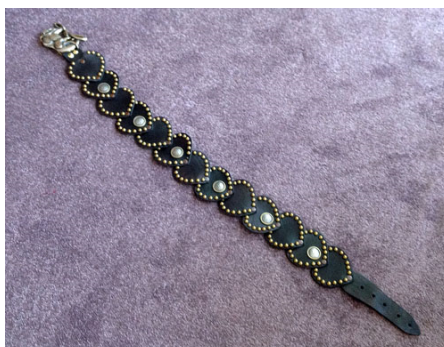
