Exciting new Membership benefit - Excess Plus Insurance

Is there a cost?

Yes. The cost will be \$20 per member, per year and is inclusive of fees and charges.

To put it into perspective; you only need to have one claim every 25 years to make this policy beneficial to you as this is how long it would take to pay \$500 at \$20 a year.

How do I obtain cover?

At this stage; we are required to get a minimum number of people interested in subscribing to the product. It is for this reason we have asked Everest Risk Group to create an online survey to capture initial interest for this new product.

We ask you select **one person** in your Shed to coordinate the level of interest; and, to complete the online survey on behalf of the membership.

Please do not send the link to individual Shed members to complete themselves.

If we meet the minimum numbers required, we will issue you an invoice based on the members nominated in the survey.

Unlike the other insurance policies we hold, there are certain personal details the insurer needs to capture in order to confirm coverage. This is simply your name as shown on your licence and your date of birth.

The details you give will be used for no other purpose other than that required to administer the policy and process claims.

If the policy meets the minimum demand; then, approximately 4 weeks after the inception, you will be issued a personalised wallet card which lists the policy number; your name; and, how to make a claim.

We are very excited by this opportunity, and thank all those involved in putting it together.

In order to register your interest, please arrange for **one** person within your Shed to coordinate the names and details of those interested; and, then complete the survey.

We ask you also review the [Frequently Asked Questions](#) in order to familiarise yourself with the details of the policy.
